- Materials: Preferable Illustration board, color pencils, and Black Permanent Marker-Fine point, Sketchbook
- > Objectives:
 - 1. Development is a character and a back-story.
 - 2. Develop characters in a sketchbook.
 - 3. Illustrate a character from 4 views, front, side, back, and ³/₄ view on illustration board.
 - 4. Use color pencil and black permanent marker to add color to their character.
 - 5. Add a 1 inch boarder to their project.
